# **Principal Report**

## **Salvos Generosity Challenge Christmas 2022**

Beaumont Hills PS will participate in the Salvos Generosity Challenge this year. We will collect hamper items for those families in need to help give them a brighter Christmas. Below is a list of items we will collect on behalf of the Salvos. Please ensure the goods you donate have a long use by date.

### COVID-19

We have had an increase in the number of students contracting COVID19. Students in Kindergarten, Year 2 and Year 4 and staff who worked with these groups of students may have had contact with a person who was infectious with COVID-19.

While testing and isolation is no longer mandatory for being exposed to someone with COVID-19 in school settings, NSW Health has provided advice on testing guidelines for our school communities following exposure to COVID-19 that should be considered when making decisions for your child and family if this situation arises at school.



You are reminded that students and staff should not attend school if they are showing any symptoms of COVID-19. These include fever, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, runny nose, loss of smell/taste, muscle/joint pains, diarrhoea, nausea/vomiting, extreme tiredness, unexplained chest pain or conjunctivitis (eye infection).

If symptoms occur at any time, your child should not attend school and is encouraged to undertake a rapid antigen test. If you cannot access a rapid antigen test, you can attend a PCR (nose and throat swab) testing clinic. If your child tests positive they should not attend school while displaying any symptoms. Students attending school are strongly encouraged to wear masks following a positive test or if they have been exposed to COVID-19. You are encouraged to register any positive test on the Service NSW website or Service NSW app so that you can be linked to important health care support and advice, and inform your school of the positive test result. Parents and carers are reminded to please ensure that you select your school name when prompted when registering a positive test for your child.

The safety and wellbeing of our students and staff across NSW are paramount at all times. As such, we will continue to ensure that all necessary health advice is closely followed.

The original production of 'A Goldilocks Mystery' is only 2 weeks away! (November 24)



- 2. Cash Put the total about due in an envelope with your child/children's CLASS and FULL NAME and send to office or directly to the school canteen.




## **Canteen Line-Up**
