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# **Relieving Principal's Report**

Welcome back to yet another exciting term!

Since we wrapped up Term 1 our teachers have spent countless hours preparing engaging units of work to support the academic learning and wellbeing needs of our students for the upcoming term. We are incredibly lucky to have such a professional and highly skilled team caring for and working with our students.

#### Staffing update

As per a recent email, Ms Welsh is currently on leave. At this stage this will continue for an additional week. During this time I will undertake the Relieving Principal role, Mr Copeman will relieve as Deputy Principal, Mrs Bates will relieve as the Stage 2 Assistant Principal and Mrs Kennedy will continue to teach 4C.

#### COVID-19 update

A new term saw a new set of Covid-19 guidelines released. Whilst all information is accessible to families via the NSW Department of Education website (<u>https://education.nsw.gov.au/covid-19/advice-for-families</u>), some key points of note are:

- Positive cases must isolate for 7 days (5 school days). The school must be notified.
- Staff and students **cannot attend school if they are showing ANY symptoms of COVID** (unless medical clearance for alternate causes has been provided)
- Students and staff who are household contacts **but have no symptoms** can continue to attend school if they follow the following guidelines:
  - They <u>must notify the school</u> if they are intending to return under this provision
  - They <u>should conduct daily RAT</u> and return a negative result each morning before attending school for five days
  - Primary school students are <u>recommended to wear a mask indoors (except when eating or</u> exercising)
- Masks are <u>recommended for students and staff who have recovered from COVID-19</u>, <u>completed</u> <u>their 7 day isolation period and are no longer showing symptoms for an additional 3 days</u> (from days 8-10 after receiving a positive test)
- Masks are <u>recommended for staff and students when returning to school as close contacts for 5</u>
  <u>school days</u>

#### NAPLAN

From May 10 - May 20 our Year 3 and Year 5 students will participate in several NAPLAN assessments for reading, writing, language conventions and numeracy. These assessments are completed online with the exception of Year 3 writing, which is completed on paper. All students require their own headphones for these assessments as some aspects are read aloud to them. Please ensure your child has their headphones at school by the end of Week 2 so they are well prepared and organised.

#### **OC Applications**

Students in Year 4 this year are eligible to sit a placement test to determine entry into an Opportunity Class in 2023. These classes are only accessible via the entry test with placements offered based on academic results. <u>Applications for this test close on Friday 13 May, 2022</u>.

To apply, parents are carers ,must complete the online application form by the due date as late applications cannot be accepted. <u>https://shsoc.education.nsw.gov.au/</u>

The Opportunity Class Placement Test will be conducted on Thursday 28 July 2022.

Thank you to Dana Sampath, who attended our last P&C meeting to talk about Primary Ethics classes at Beaumont Hills Public School. Highlights of her presentation are as follows:

- Ethics classes are an option for parents who opt out of scripture
- Ethics classes are facilitated discussions on topical issues children discuss issues with each other, and develop skills of critical thinking, active listening, respectful discussion, self-confident and well-reasoned views, with the aim of becoming empathetic contributors to society.
- Run by volunteers mostly from the parent community and their network of family and friends.
- No need for teaching experience, all our volunteers are provided with free training and full lesson scripts
- If you volunteer, you need to commit to a full school year, and be available for a 30 min class each school week (same time each week.)
- Can start at any time of the year- no need to start in Term 1
