Student Reports

Next week Semester 1 reports will be made available through Sentral. I am in the process of reading all student reports and can see the progress students have made this year. All students will have learning goals for English and mathematics. The general comment explains your child's learning behaviours, social interactions and any other relevant observations concerning your child in the classroom and, in many cases across the broader school community. Please take time to go through your child's report with them. Talk to your child about their learning, likes and dislikes, strengths and weaknesses. All BHPS students are to be congratulated on their achievements this semester.

Teaching and Learning

So far this year teachers have focused on improving the teaching and learning of reading and mathematics in classrooms. Teachers meet every five weeks and analyse 'data'. This data may be assessment results, student observations and/or work samples. Each student's learning is evaluated against outcomes and indicators in line with NSW syllabus documents. Class teaching and learning programs are constantly adjusted as a result of these 'data talks' and student learning is differentiated according to each student's needs. We are committed to every child reaching their learning potential and class teachers know each of their students extremely well. When reading student reports I see the evidence of this.

Parent/Teacher Interviews

Parent/teacher interviews will be held during Week 10 (week beginning 27 June). Parents will be offered meetings either via Zoom or telephone. Further details and booking times and instructions will be sent out as soon as possible. Please take advantage of this opportunity to discuss your child's learning so far this year, as well as goals for the remainder of the year.

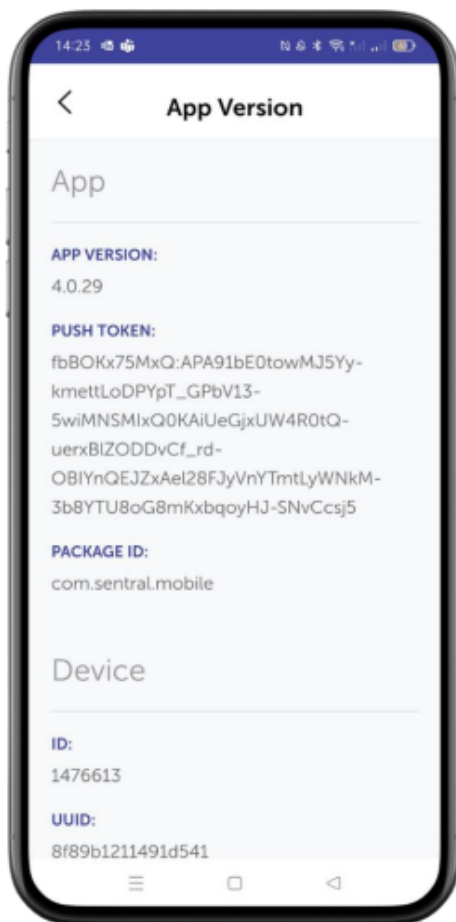
Important Information: Sentral for Parents App

How do I check what version I am?

From your app, go into Settings cog in the top left corner of the dashboard screen, then into App Version. (See image below.)

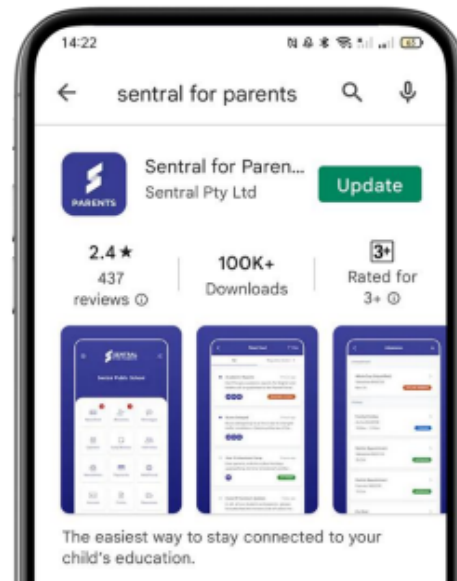


I am on Version 3 or 4

3. A Proof of double-dose Covid-19 Vaccination

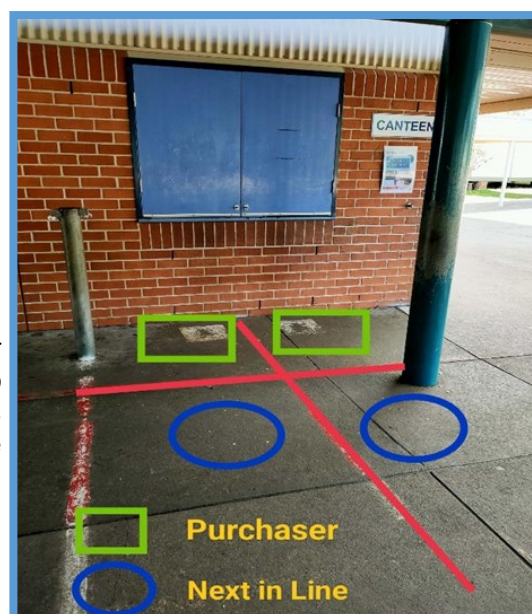

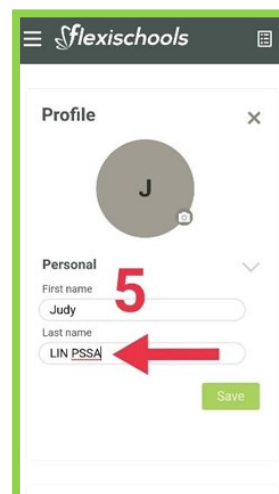
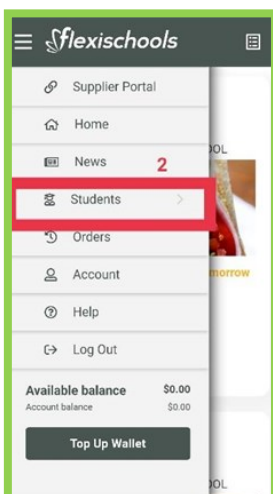
