Principal's Report

Congratulations

Last week our many of our students were lucky enough to be entertained by both of our school bands. Principal's Report

Student Reports

Next week Semester 1 reports will be made available through Sentral. I am in the process of reading all student reports and can see the progress students have made this year. All students will have learning goals for English and mathematics. The general comment explains your child's learning behaviours, social interactions and any other relevant observations concerning your child in the classroom and, in many cases across the broader school community. Please take time to go through your child's report with them. Talk to your child about their learning, likes and dislikes, strengths and weaknesses. All BHPS students are to be congratulated on their achievements this semester.

Teaching and Learning

So far this year teachers have focused on improving the teaching and learning of reading and mathematics in classrooms. Teachers meet every five week and analyse 'data'. This data may be assessment results, student observations and/or work samples. Each student's learning is evaluated against outcomes and indicators in line with NSW syllabus documents. Class teaching and learning programs are constantly adjusted as a result of these 'data talks' and student learning is differentiated according to each student's needs. We are committed to every child reaching their learning potential and class teachers know each of their students extremely well. When reading student reports I see the evidence of this.

Parent/Teacher Interviews

Parent/teacher interviews will be held during Week 10 (week beginning 27 June). Parents will be offered meetings either via Zoom or telephone. Further details and booking times and instructions will be sent out as soon as possible. How do I check what version I am?

From your app, go into Settings cog in the top left corner of the dashboard screen, then into App Version. (See image below.)

You will need to update your app. Go to your device's app store and search for Sentral for Parents and then select Update (see image below). Or you can access the app store using the QR codes below. After the update, when you go back into the app, you will be required to re-enter your login credentials.
