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Principal's Report

Organisation

We are currently experiencing a number of staff absences, all of which are necessary. We are finding it increasingly difficult to replace teachers for day to day absences, and there are times when classes are needing to be split more than we would like. Covering classes takes priority over our very important support programs, and we are regularly using the teachers of these programs to cover classes. I am grateful to our parent community for remaining patient when children come home saying they have been sent to 'split classes' twice and on rare occasions three times in a week. If other options were available to us they would be taken.

When students are split to other classes they work with that class wherever possible and appropriate. The split booklets that the children take with them are filled with a range of activities, fulfilling curriculum outcomes, including reading, writing and mathematics. It is an expectation that students undertake these key learning areas every day and supervising teachers do monitor the work of all students.

NAIDOC WEEK PERFORMANCE (delayed from actual NAIDOC Week)

On Monday we had the Koomurri people come to our school and teach us about the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander cultures. We had a smoking ceremony, a didgeridoo master show, a dance show and also some story telling. They taught us about the Aboriginal artifacts, weaponry, bush survival and they even painted our faces with paint made from ochre rock. It was a great experience and we all really enjoyed the day.
