KINDERGARTEN-2023 ENROLMENTS

We are currently accepting enrolments for Kindergarten-2023. If you or any family and friends have any children who will be enrolling into kindergarten next year and are planning to enrol at Beaumont Hills PS, please refer to the information below.

We will need the following paperwork to complete your child's enrolment:

- Completed Enrolment Form: Online Enrolment via our school website: beaumont-hill.p.schools.nsw.gov.au . Please ensure you attach the enrolment paperwork under the "Supporting Documents" section of the Online Enrolment.
- A copy of the Enrolment form for families who do not meet the Online Enrolment criteria can be found on our school website under the enrolments tab.
- Child's Birth Certificate/Passport-need to sight original document-prior to 2023
- Immunisation up to 4 years
- Also, if you &/or your child/children were born overseas, we require Visa/Citizenship Details and passports. If you are now Australian Citizens, we require your Citizenship Certificate or Australian Passport. We need to sight original passports-prior to 2023
- Proof of Address: Residential address check(100 point proof of address)
- Contract of Sale/Council Rates or Co-Signed Lease Agreement
- 2x Utility Bills-from different companies (E.g.: Water & Electricity bill)
- 2x supporting paperwork such as: Driver's Licence, Internet, Phone Bill, Insurance policy, car registration, bank statement etc.
- **(Please note: if you have another child already enrolled at BHPS and you still reside within our school catchment area, you are only required to provide 1x bill proving your current address. However, if you have moved since enrolling with us and are no longer residing in our catchment, you will need to complete the Online "Out of Area" Application. These "Out of Area" applications need to be approved by our Panel, where they are assessed individually, and outcomes advised as soon as possible. An Out of Area Application can be completed online via the enrolment link on our school website.**

1. A Working with Children Check - Declaration for Volunteers and Non-Child-Related Contractors, (Click link below for the form.)

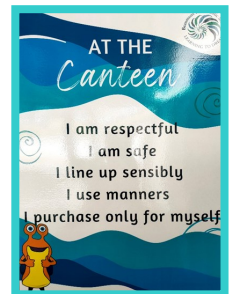
