BOOKING DEADLINE

Please note all bookings made by Wednesday 06 December 2023 to ensure statements can be sent by Friday 08 December 2023. After this date, all dates will be capped and bookings with availability will need to be requested through email at admin@jigsawoosh.com.au - bookings will incur a late booking fee as shown below.

LATE BOOKING FEE

Bookings added after the booking deadline date will incur a \$5.00 late booking fee per late booking. To avoid late surcharges in bookings, we encourage families to book by the closing date so that Jigsaw 00SH can plan staffing , activities, meals and resources accordingly

CHILD CARE SUBSIDY

Please note that if you have not attended the service in the last 14 weeks you must re-confirm your enrolment on your MyGov account to receive CCS rebates. Jigsaw OOSH cannot do this on your behalf.

CANCELLATIONS OF BOOKINGS

Fees will apply if Jigsaw has not received sufficient written notice.

Cancelling your booking with less than a weeks notice - The booking will be removed and replaced with a \$20.00 fee.

Cancelling your booking with 24 hours' notice or less - The booking will be removed and is replaced with a fee that is half of the non-subsidised cost for the booking on that day.

Cancelling on the day – The booking will be marked as absent and full fees will apply. Please email all cancellations to admin@jigsawoosh.com.au

BOOKING VACATION CARE

Log Onto your My Family Lounge App.

Go to your Sessions Tab with the calendar icon and choose the "VAC" roll.

Go to the Vacation Care Period and select your desired date.

4) Once you select your desired date, a pop up will appear. This holds information for the day and T&C's. Scroll down to the bottom of the page and select "Book Session"

5) Once you have successfully booked in your Vacation Care booking, on the calendar the desired date will appear with a "Purple" underline.

Repeat step Four and Five for all other desired dates.
