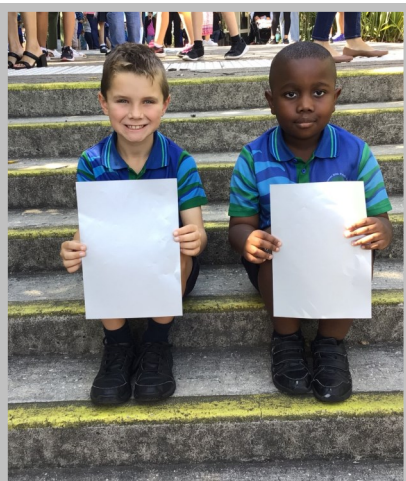

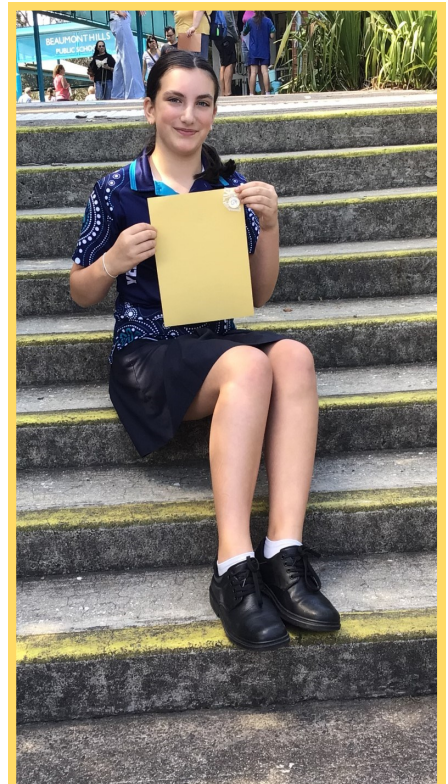

- If your child/children need to leave school early but have a lunch order on the day, feel free to come to canteen to pick up before you leave.

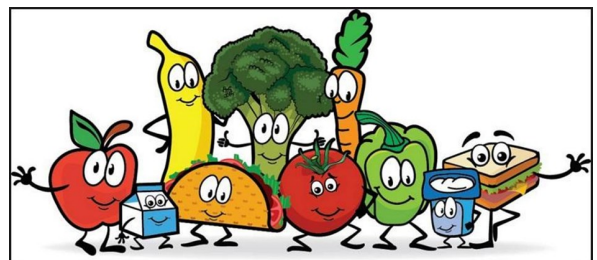
