Mrs Armstrong has contributed to the education and sense of belonging to so many children in Beaumont Hills, I can't even guess how many! Thank you to Mrs Armstrong for her commitment to the children of Beaumont Hills Public School. We are hoping to still see Mrs Armstrong as a casual teacher with us.

Mrs Selwood began at Beaumont Hills PS in 2001. She has worked in the office as a school administrative officer, and then the school administrative manager. Mrs Selwood approaches staff, students and parents with a smile, care and attention to detail. No request goes un-followed up and she does her best to make sure the front face of our school, the office, is a friendly and respectful place to be. Mrs Kirkness is leaving us this week to start at the new school in Box Hill. Mrs Kirkness began teaching here in 2019. Mrs Kirkness has been a driving force in making sure that teaching and learning pedagogies are researched based, and has led to significant improvement in student learning outcomes. Mrs Kirkness is a favourite of our students, and will be sorely missed. Box Hill Public School is very fortunate to have Mrs Kirkness as one of its foundation Assistant Principals. I wish Mrs Kirkness every happiness in her new role.

Mrs Reddy will not be working with us next year. She has been offered and accepted a role at another school that is closer to home for her. As well as being a wonderful classroom teacher, Mrs Reddy has worked with our Stage 1 dance group, and as demonstrated through their performances, most recently Presentation Day, Mrs Reddy has done a wonderful job with these students. Thank you Mrs Reddy for your work here over the past 2 years.

Mrs Bates will be taking leave for the duration of 2025 for some much-deserved travel. We will see Mrs Bates when she returns in 2026.

Two of our SLSOs, Mrs Sharma and Mrs Sajjad, are both leaving us this year as they move interstate. We are grateful for the work they have both done with our students and teachers and wish them every success in the future.

Miss Peisley has been offered a position at another school for 2025. Miss Peisley has worked at BHPS this year as a teacher, and before that as and SLSO while completing her degree. Besides teaching students, Miss Peisley has done a wonderful job in developing our dance groups. She will be much missed and we wish her well as she officially begins her teaching career.

In 2025 we will have two multi-categorical inclusion and support classes. We have staff ready to open these classes. These staff members will be introduced at the beginning of 2025, as will replacement assistant principals covering Mrs Bates and Miss Gregory (who Mrs Kirkness was replacing). We are also in the process of finalising the merit selection process for a general assistant and school administration manager.





Beaumont Hills PS Band Program – 2024

Dear Parents,

Welcome back, and a very special welcome to our new students and parents! We are looking forward to another great year of making music. Correspondence will be via email: please ensure TSA has your current email address and check your junk/spam folder for communications.

NEW BEGINNERS *(those learning an instrument for the first time in 2024)*

There are two components to the Band Program: group lessons and a full band rehearsal both held on the same day. **Please note, all group lessons take place after school.** Your band director will email you with further details.

- **Group lessons:** Start Thursday 8 February (a timetable will be emailed to parents by your band director)
- **What to bring:** Instrument if already purchased; items ordered through TSA will be distributed in the first lesson.
- **Full Band Rehearsal:** Beginners will not be required at band rehearsal **until Term 2**. Training Band rehearsals will be on Thursdays at lunchtime.

The first lesson will focus on showing new students how to set-up and care for their instruments.

EXISTING BAND STUDENTS *(those who already learned an instrument in 2023)*

- **Full band rehearsal:** Starts Thursday 8 February at 2:00-2:45pm in the Hall
- **Group lessons:** Start Thursday 8 February (after school). A timetable will be emailed to parents.
- **What to bring:** Instrument & pencil, *Accent on Achievement* book and band folder.

The first lesson will focus on finalising grouping and assessing how continuing students have progressed across the summer holiday break.

IMPORTANT ITEMS

Fees – In 2024, band and group tuition fees will be \$220 per term plus \$10 resource levy. TSA will email invoices/process direct debits at the beginning of each school term and needs to be finalised within 2 weeks of issue or late fees will apply.

Absence from Band – if your child will be absent from band or lessons please notify the band director. In particular, absences outside of school hours must be communicated clearly so we can confirm your child is safe and accounted for.

Creative Kids Vouchers – TSA is a registered provider and families with Creative Kids Vouchers can apply them to term fees by entering voucher details via the TSA website here: <https://teachingservices.com.au/creative-kids/>.

Exiting the Band Program – TSA requires notice by the end of any term if your child wishes to exit from the program in the next term.
