## Principal's Report

### Learning@home

Thank you to our school community for adhering to the current restrictions and keeping children learning from home wherever possible. The current health orders in place state that parents must keep children at home unless they need to be at school, that is children of parents who are essential workers working outside of the home. A minimum number of staff are allowed to be at school to supervise those children who need to be at school. These children are undertaking the same learning packages as most of our students who are learning at home.

I have seen lots of fabulous work from our students (supported by their parents in many cases) which demonstrates the high level of engagement that is currently occurring. The combined efforts of our teachers, students and parents are commendable.

Teachers and students are connecting through Zoom catchups and Google Classroom. Mrs Flanagan is providing story time twice a week. Miss James, Miss Sims and Mrs Sathe have begun small group learning and support tutorials for targeted students. Last week we began a help hub which, after initially proving very successful, will continue on Tuesdays and Thursdays to support students with specific questions. I strongly encourage students to access this resource regularly.

If you have concerns with supporting your child learning at home please contact the school via email so we can contact you to better support any issues. Teachers are contacting families through phone and email if they are not having regular contact with a child through Google Classroom and Zoom. These are both wellbeing and learning check ins. We need evidence that every child is engaging in learning as roll marking remains a requirement. Children are marked with 'flexible' attendance to indicate they are learning at home during this time.
