Changes to Linen/Pillows

 Please be advised that students must bring their own linen (sleeping bag or doona and two single flat sheets) and pillows to camp as they have been removed from current service offerings to ensure the highest possible hygiene standards. COVID guidelines

In line with current guidelines, we are implementing the following protocols:

- All students and staff are asked to do a Rapid Antigen Test on the Sunday night prior to camp and receive a negative result in order to attend. If positive, please email the school.
- Students and staff who have cold and flu like symptoms are unable to attend.
- Students and staff who are close contacts to positive cases are not permitted to attend overnight activities.
- Students who develop symptoms whilst on camp will be issued a Rapid Antigen Test and isolated. Parents must collect any symptomatic students from the camp within a reasonable time from notification. Please be aware that it is a 1-hour drive to Narrabeen. All parents must have a plan in place if requested.
- Students are required to wear a mask on the bus.

When providing permission for your child to attend the camp you are agreeing to the above conditions and any additional protocols put in place by the NSW Department of Education or NSW Health Department at the time of the camp.
