“MYSTERY OF GOLDBLOCKS” COSTUME REQUIREMENTS

Dear Parents/Caregivers

Our end of year performance “**Mystery of Goldilocks**” is a whole school production. All classes are involved in the production through drama, dance or playing a musical instrument. The “**Mystery of Goldilocks**” is based on a variety of traditional fairy tale stories as well as some of the more recent bedtime stories where all the characters come together to attend a Fairy QuestAcon workshop for the weekend.

The BHPS gates open at 5:00pm so families can visit the market stalls and food trucks prior to the performance at 6:30pm.

The following classes are required to bring:

KW & KG Students: Pyjamas / Nightgown (sleeping hat will be provided by the school)

4C Students: Students will be dressing as farm animals. Students will receive a note before the end of this term letting parents know which animal their child will be and what colour T-shirt and pants / shorts to provide.

ALL OTHER CLASSES – except for KG, KW and 4C

Most of these classes make up the chorus and who will need to provide their own costumes keeping with the theme of **bedtime stories**. The students in these classes’ costumes may be made up of costumes recently used in book week. Any student who is unable to source a costume will be able to borrow from the school.

Below is a suggestion of books that could be used as inspiration for characters. Students do not have to be the lead character from the book. For example, you could dress as the coach driver from Cinderella.

Peter Pan and the lost boys	Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs	Cinderella and the Ugly sisters
Hansel and Gretel	The Elves and the Shoemaker	Cat in the Hat
Beauty and the Beast	The Gingerbread Man	Wizard of OZ

LEAD ROLES

Any student that has been allocated a class **lead role** for the performance will be provided with a costume. They will be required to wear either black or white shoes. Goldilocks will need white shoes. Detectives and police to wear black school shoes.
