Term 3 Week 9 Friday 21 September	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mr Ross and Mr Vella will address the Year 5 students in preparation for becoming a 2019 School Leader. Qualities of leadership will be discussed. A timeline presented to students.
Term 4 Week 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Student Leader applications will be available to all Year 5 students on the school website and via email to parents
Term 4 Week 6 Monday 19 November	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All completed House Leader Application forms are to be given to the office on or before 19 November. NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED (If you are away on holidays please submit the application to the school email address by Monday 19 November)
Term 4 Week 7 Thursday 22 November	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students will find out if they will be required to attend an interview. This will be determined by the number of applications received.
Term 4 Week 7 Monday 26 or Tuesday 27 November	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Principal to inform successful applicants that they will be a part of the 2019 School Leadership team. Letters sent to parents of successful 2019 school leaders. Positions will not be announced until Presentation Assembly.
Term 4 Week 7 Wednesday 28 November	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Interviews for House Leader will take place at lunch times with Mr Copeman and Mrs Rowsell. This process is again dependent on the number of applications.
Term 4 Week 8 Monday 3 December	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students will present a short speech during a house meeting to put forward their case to represent their house as a House Leader for 2019. Voting will take place immediately after speeches in house groups.
Term 4 Week 8 Thursday 6 December	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students will be informed if they have been successful in gaining a position as a House Leader for 2019. Letters sent to parents of successful 2019 School Leaders. Positions will not be announced until Presentation Assembly.
