Next year students will be presented with other leadership opportunities, including roles as library and peer play leaders.

School captain	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Model and promote excellent behaviour and wearing of complete school uniform Work on ways to improve student friendships, promoting general happiness and acceptance of others at Beaumont Hills Attend meetings and lead Student Representative Council by taking on roles of Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer Act as hosts/guides at assemblies, Presentation Day, Open Days, Music Festival, Grandparents Day and performances, making speeches when required Suggest and organise special events or areas of interest/concern of value to BHPS.

House leader	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provide leadership of the 4 houses: Knight, Pearce, Redden, Sherwood Assist with the running of sports carnivals Take responsibility for providing sports equipment for use at lunch times Organise lunch time sports activities and work with younger students to teach them games and sports Encourage student participation in sport. Assist in organisation and running of house events and days.

This week Year 5 students met with their teachers to discuss the school leader and house leader programs for next year. They have been invited to apply for leadership positions via a Google Form.

Term 4 Week 1 (14-18 Oct)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Year 5 teachers will discuss leadership qualities and values with students. Timeline presented to students. Mon 28/10 Term 4 Week 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Applications due by 3pm Mon 28/10/2023 NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED
Term 4 Week 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Applications will be reviewed and shortlisted based on the application. Selection panel will consist of Stage 3 teachers and an executive. Applicants applying for student leadership roles will be advised if they progress to interview and be given an interview time.
Term 4 Week 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Potential student leaders will participate in small group interviews (3 – 4 students). Interview panel will consist of teachers and current student leaders. Final students who progress to speeches will be informed and given advice and feedback on their campaign poster and speech preparation.

Term 4 Week 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Posters are displayed. ● Potential student leaders will introduce themselves to the school at a morning school assembly.
Term 4 Week 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 8 boys and 8 girls student leader nominees will present speeches to the school at an assembly. ● All students vote for their most suitable candidates. ● Votes will be collated. ● Students will have their speeches filmed for any students and staff absent on the day.
Term 4 Week 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The top 4 boys and 4 girls will be notified of their success by a member of the school executive. ● Students who were unsuccessful in becoming a school leader may have nominated that they would like to be a house captain and will have the opportunity to be selected into one of these roles.
Term 4 Week 7	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students applying for house leader roles may present speeches to their houses. ● Students may vote for the most suitable house captains. ● Votes will be collated (if voting occurs).
Term 4 Week 8	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● House Leaders will be notified of their success at the Sports Presentation assembly.
Term 4 Week 9	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 2025 School Leader positions will be announced to the school at Presentation Assembly. (<i>Details to be confirmed</i>)
